

Mess staffs will be added in accordance with the scales laid down in A.C.I. 1223 of 1942. One batwoman will be added for every 3 officers on the staff and 1 for every 5 officer students.

4. If the number of students is 240 or above -

Commandant will be lieutenant-colonel.

Adjutant will be captain.

Chief instructor will be major.

Company serjeant-major will be regimental serjeant-major.

Company quarter-master-serjeant will be regimental quarter-master-serjeant.

One administrative officer (captain), 1 assistant armourer, 1 batman for commandant, 2 pistols, .38-inch, and 1 rifle, .303-inch will be added.

5. The following special increment is authorized for Scottish Command Weapon Training School, subject to review on 1st January, 1943: -
